Requirements

You must complete one activity for each of the 4 requirements below between now and the end of the year.

Have the scout write up how they accomplished each requirement on a handwritten sheet of paper or type it up on the computer.

This adventure should be completed at home with the help of the family. Thanksgiving time makes a lot of sense, or if your religion has a time of year that makes it easier to complete the requirements. Note: an alternative to completing this adventure is to obtain a Religious Emblem of the Scout's family choosing. Acceptable Religious Emblems are on the Scouting.org adventure site.

Requirement 1 With your parent or legal guardian, talk about your family's faith traditions. Identify three holidays or celebrations that are part of your family's faith traditions. Make a craft, work of art, or a food item that is part of your family's faith traditions. Examples on Scouting.org include making a collage or wood craft.	Requirement 2 Carry out an act of kindness. Examples on Scouting.org include helping with chores or helping a neighbor. Scouting for Food would also apply.
Requirement 3 With your parent or legal guardian identify a religion or faith that is different from your own. Identify two things that it has in common with your family's beliefs. Examples on Scouting.org include learning 2 things from another faith and comparing to your own.	Requirement 4 Discuss with our parent or legal guardian what it means to be reverent. Tell how you practice being reverent in your daily life. Examples on Scouting.org include learning how to be reverent in every day life.
